

Q7 Which of the following descriptions accurately describes the standardized testing practices of your students? Please check all that apply.






Q23 Which best describes the average FTE (Full Time Equivalent) caseload in your office (i.e. # of seniors divided by the number of FTE college counselors)?

Q28 Does the compensation for your other counselors include housing?
















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Q39 Do you limit the number of applications a student can submit?






